## Booking Information

**Tuition charges:** Charges differ depending on the type of tuition (private/shared lessons or clinics) and number of students in each session. **Travel expenses:** No cost up to 15 miles of Spalding, 40p per mile thereafter. Please contact Jody to confirm details.

**Payment & cancellation policy:** A 50% deposit is required to secure bookings. Deposit will be forfeited if student cancels without a doctor/veterinary note. Deposits will only be returned if the instructor cancels the tuition.

Tuition will carry on whatever the weather unless the instructor deems it unsafe and cancels, e.g. extreme weather conditions.

**Other policies:** Students must be a minimum of 16 years of age. Students under 18 years of age must obtain a parent's signature for permission to attend. Savvy Club membership is required. Please advise if you require a Savvy Club membership application form.

## Agreement & Liability Release

### Rider specifications:

- Applicants under 18 yrs require a parent or guardian to sign front of this form.
- Physically riders must be able and reasonably fit, well balanced on a horse at all gaits.
- As a matter of safety Jody Ruysen reserves the right to recommend that you do not ride.

### Rider requirements:

- A basic equipment kit is required comprising of a natural halter, 12ft line, carrot stick and 6ft savvy string, together with your saddle, riding boots/shoes with a small heel\* and hard hat\*. For level 2 tuition you will require a 22ft line, a further carrot stick, snaffle bridle and optionally a bareback pad.

### Important for insurance reasons the following are required:

- BS standard approved helmet to be worn at all times when mounted.
- Helmet must comply with PASO15 or EN1384 and must be less than five years old from the date of manufacture.
- Helmets must be properly fitted including the use of the chinstrap.
- Helmets that have had a significant impact, which has affected the strength of the helmet must not be worn.
- Appropriate heeled shoes or boots.
- Parelli approved equipment.

### Your horse:

- Your horse must be started under saddle for a riding session.
- Please do not bring horses with serious behavioural problems on a course/workshop.
- Stallions are not permitted.

### Terms and conditions:

- The applicant agrees to release and discharge the instructor in respect of all liability to the applicant for loss or damage of any kind, whether for personal injury, death or property damage which the applicant may suffer from attending the course/workshop/lesson howsoever caused.
- The applicant hereby indemnifies the instructor from any loss, liability or damage or cost that may be incurred by the instructor as a result of any act or omission, whether caused by negligence of the applicant or otherwise in respect of any injury, loss or damage of any person who may accompany the applicant to the course/workshop/lesson may suffer whilst at the course/workshop/lesson.
- This agreement, releases and indemnities shall be binding upon the applicant, the applicant's legal representative, heirs and next of kin, and that this agreement may be pleaded in bar to any cause of action commenced in any court contrary to the terms and conditions.
- Various words and phrases used in this agreement shall have the following meanings: the 'instructor' also includes any partners, employees, agents or sub-contractors who may run or assist in running the

course/workshop/lesson. The 'course/workshop/lesson' refers to any instructions, training or demonstrations relating to the starting, training, selection, care, handling and riding of horses.
